2. No plastic canvas items accepted in Needlework Division (see Department 30, Adult Crafts and Hobbies)
3. Items should be blocked, pressed, clean and free of animal hair.
4. Identify your level of skill by marking whether you are a Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced or youth exhibitor.

- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

Small Display: size allowed up to 24" x 36" maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11" x 17" minimum.
