ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 15, 2017 (After 8/15/17, late fees will apply.)
- Entries will be physically accepted at the Home Arts Building, Friday prior to Fair at 10:00 am – 7:00 pm ONLY.
- All exhibits remain on display until the close of Fair, and must be picked up between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm Monday, Labor Day.

OPEN STAMPING & SCRAPBOOKING RULES

RUBBER STAMPING

1. All items must be stamped or digital only.
2. No pre-colored computer images accepted.
3. Items will be judged on creativity, use of color, neatness and techniques used.
4. One Entry per Class Only

SCRAPBOOKING

5. Page must be enclosed in page protector/sleeve. Superintendent/staff will attach Velcro to the back of the protector sheet for hanging. Velcro is not removable. Hint: keep page protectors for use in future entries
6. Layouts will be judged on creativity, originality, craftsmanship. Pages must include photo(s) and journaling. Overall appearance, use of color and design are critical.
7. Small layouts/albums include 5x7, 7x7 and similar sizes. Medium layouts, /albums include 8 ½ x11, 9x12 and similar sizes. Large layouts/albums include those 12x12 and larger.
8. Any questions regarding clarifications should be directed to the superintendents prior to or at the time of entry.

9. Items cannot be over 15"x15"x15"; and must be at least 2.5"x 2.5"x 2.5".
10. Kits can be used, but must show some originality with decorating theme.
11. Items are judged on creativity, originality, craftsmanship. Overall appearance, use of color, use of bling and other decor will be taken into consideration.

DIVISION 37-F OPEN STAMPING & SCRAPBOOKING EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY

Space is limited. Pre-register by calling the Superintendent, so space can be incorporated into the Department area.

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g. tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display

Small Display: size allowed up to 24" x 36" maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11" x 17" minimum.
