#### 4H SWINE RULES

1. Arrive/vet check: 7:00 am – 10:00 am, In place no later than 10:30 am
2. Please read Livestock Guide for general animal rules and requirements

#### 3. Market & Feeder Rules

- Individual may be shown out of pens as single entry.
  - All breeds competing together.
  - Only hogs entered in CLASS 52-B (Market Hogs) are eligible for the Market Sale and Carcass Awards.
  - Minimum and maximum weight requirements for market animals are subject to change at the discretion of the packer.
4. Feeding hours during Fair: 7:00 am and 5:00 pm.
  5. No feeding after 8:00 am Monday.

#### DIVISION 52-A ..... FITTING AND SHOWING

The same hog must be shown for the championship round as in the initial fitting and showing round. The top ten exhibitors in each Class will receive a placing ribbon in addition to the Danish placing ribbon.

#### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 75

Red ..... 60

White ..... 45

#### CLASSES

01 - Junior (ages 8-10)

02 - Intermediate (ages 11-13)

03 - Senior (age 14-19)

04 - Novice (Divisions are open to juniors that have never shown an animal of any species. All seniors will show in their division.)

#### DIVISION 52-B ..... MARKET & FEEDER HOGS

- All Breeds Show Together
- All market animals not making weight (240-300) will be moved to Feeder Division or Heavy Division by Judge and Superintendent.

Blue ..... 60

Red ..... 40

White ..... 20

**CLASS 01 – Top 15 Market Hogs**

The top 15 Market Hogs will receive a placing rosette ribbon in addition to the grouping ribbon.

**DIVISION 52-E .....HOG CARCASS**

Additional Hog of Merit carcasses will receive 20 points.

**CLASS 01 – Hog Carcass**

Carcasses meeting the following specifications will qualify for Hog of Merit. Premium points: 20

**Hog of Merit (240-300 lbs) Specifications:**

- Adjusted Rib Fat. Fat thickness over the 10th rib, as measured by ultrasound, must be .5-.85", rounded to the nearest one-hundredth.
- Muscling. Carcasses must have a minimum of 5.0 square inches of loin-eye, measured by ultrasound, rounded to the nearest tenth of an inch.
- Average Daily Gain. Minimum of 1.70 pounds per day fed a minimum of 75 days before the show. Placement of carcasses will be made on the basis of an index for cut ability and gain.

**CHAMPION HOG CARCASS**

**The Kittitas County Fair** will award a Trophy for the Champion Hog Carcass.

The Carcass Incentive Committee will award cash prizes to Top Hog of Merit.

**ALL AROUND CARCASS HOG**

**Kittitas County Farm Bureau** will sponsor a belt buckle to the market hog exhibitor who attains the highest combined score in Hog Carcass placing (25%), Market Hog placing (25%), Livestock Judging (25%), and Hog Showmanship (25%). Ties will be broken by hogs with the highest placing in the Hog Carcass Contest.

**PHIL BLOOM CARCASS AWARD**

Exhibitors of the top beef, lamb and hog carcasses shall have their names placed on a perpetual plaque displayed in the Extension Office. Donated by the **Kittitas County Cattlemen's Association**.
