ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 15, 2017 (After 8/15/17), late fees will apply.)
- Required forms: Hold Harmless Waiver, PT. All turkeys entering Washington State for exhibition must originate from an NPIP participant flock that has met Pullorum-Typhoid, Avian Influenza, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and Mycoplasma synoviae classification requirements or has tested negative for Pullorum-Typhoid, Avian Influenza, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and Mycoplasma synoviae within 30 days of shipment.
- All clubs must enter: herdsmanship and barn decorations.
- All individuals are encouraged to enter Educational Exhibits.

4H POULTRY RULES

1. Arrive/vet check:11:00 am – 12:00 pm, In place no later than 12:00pm Wednesday, NO EXCEPTIONS. Mandatory Poultry meeting at 12:30 pm.
2. Kittitas County will not be responsible for loss or accidents, but will give every care and attention.
3. The veterinarian will remove a fowl deemed unfit due to insect or disease.
4. All exhibitors must sign the Chicken, Exotic Fowl and Game Bird P-T test waiver and release Kittitas County Fair and all other parties from liability, and free of Avian Influenza.
5. All birds must have been in the State of Washington for at least 6 months and in their present ownership for at least 90 days.
6. In filling out entry forms, the exhibitor is expected to state plainly the **sex, age, breed and variety** and must show the proper Division and Class numbers. Changes of poultry animal are only allowed up to one week before Fair.
7. Trios or pens shall be entered separately. Fowl entered in single Divisions shall not compete in trio or pens.
8. All Clubs must enter the Division AA, Herdsmanship Contest and spend time supervising the exhibits in the barn.
9. The exhibitor will provide the feeders and waterers.
10. The exhibitor is expected to properly feed, water and clean his/her fowl BEFORE 8 AM, during and at the end of each Fair Day. The Superintendent may withhold premiums if the exhibitor fails to care for his/her exhibit.
11. Advertising and "FOR SALE" signs are not permitted.
12. Specify the breed, age of bird and leg band number on the cage card.
13. All poultry will be judged by the American Poultry Association standards. The judge will withhold prizes when specimens are not of sufficient merit.
14. Pigeons and game birds will be judged at the discretion of the judge.
15. The exhibitor shall make every effort to be present when his/her exhibit is being judged.

- 16. The Superintendent may deny entry to any animal she deems unworthy of public display.
- 17. READ 4-H POLICY IN RULES

4-H FITTING & SHOWING CONTEST

Friday, 10:00 am - Bloom

- 1. Exhibitors must show birds, which they have entered as live, bird exhibits. Birds must be under 2 years of age.
- 2. The Superintendent may deny entry to any animal or exhibit he deems unworthy of public display.
- 3. Exhibitors must show breed and leg band numbers on the judging form.
- 4. Ducks, geese and turkeys will be judged in the Chicken Fitting and Showing Contest, unless four (4) or more are entered in an age group.
 - 1. 5 4-H exhibitors Dress Code.
 - 5. All exhibitors must provide a carpet square to place their bird on during competition.
 - 6. All exhibitors will be judged as individuals and as such, compete against all other contestants of the same age group for awards, both cash and ribbons.

**FITTING & SHOWING JUDGES CRITERIA
SCORING**

The following scorecard is used in judging the Poultry Fitting & Showing contests.

- Showing, handling & knowledge of bird 50%
- Condition & Appearance of bird 20%
- Conduct & appearance of exhibitor 10%
- Position & handling of bird into cage 10%
- Nomenclature tests 10%
- Total Points 100%

POULTRY JUDGING
