4H REPTILE RULES

1. NO VENOMOUS REPTILES
2. Please contact the superintendent about cage sizes, outlets and available room before entering.
3. Reptiles must be free of external parasites (i.e. ticks, mites, etc.). They must be clean with no open wounds or they will not be allowed.
4. Exhibitors will supply their own food and heating devices (lamps, rocks) if required and an escape proof container. Locks required for all snakes.
5. All reptiles will be in their cages during the hours that the exhibit is open except to participate in 4-H events, divisions and for exercises that the superintendent has approved.
6. Washington State law prohibits ownership or display of indigenous species.
