- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 15, 2017 (After 8/15/17, late fees will apply.)
- Fleeces will be received between 4 pm and 6 pm, Tuesday, prior to fair, in the 4-H building.
- Limit: three (3) fleeces per class
- Number of months’ growth of fiber required.
- Fleeces shall be well skirted.
- All individuals are encouraged to enter Educational Exhibits (See Dept. 71)
- Entries must stay on display until the end of Fair and must be picked up on Monday between 6:00 pm and 8:00pm.
