4H CLOTHING RULES

1. Open to all members in clothing projects but the exhibitor must be enrolled in the specific clothing project in which she/he exhibits.
2. Articles must be made since last year’s Fair.
3. Each article must have an attached CARE LABEL, written on a piece of paper or card giving care instructions. No care instructions will result in the ribbon value being lowered.
4. No school or FHA projects accepted.
5. Soiled articles will not be judged.
6. May enter unlimited number of items per CLASS if not repetitive and different construction technique used.

7. Contests Still Life Judging: DEPARTMENT 73, DIVISION 73B.
8. Fashion Revue enters DEPARTMENT 73, DIVISION 73GF
9. 4-H’ers may be involved in one interview judging session in each division.

CLASS 01 – SMALL SEWN ITEMS

Clothing accessories or miscellaneous sewn non-clothing (kites, small flags, book bags, back-packs, set of 4 placemats or napkins).

CLASS 03 – NON-SEWN ITEM

Fleece scarves, fleece tied blankets, quilts

CLASS 04 – GROUP ENTRY

Clothing and Textiles project completed by 2 or more members (must be entered under club name).

CLASS 05 – SMALL QUILTED OR PATCHWORK

Small quilted or Patchwork Items or other small sewn items (under 16 square feet).
