#### ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 15, 2017 (After 8/15/17, late fees will apply.)
- All individuals are encouraged to enter Educational Exhibits.

- Exhibits accepted in the 4-H Building Tuesday prior to Fair, 7:30 am - 11:30 am.

#### 4H CREATIVE KIDS RULES

1. All participants must be properly enrolled 4-H members.
2. Creative Kids Projects are open to all 4-H members, regardless of 4-H project enrollment.
3. No more than ONE (1) entry allowed per 4-H member in each Division.
4. Regular 4-H Fair entry forms and tags should be completed for all entries.
5. Judging will take place prior to the fair and entries will be on display throughout the fair.
6. Entries will be released on Monday, September 5 (6-8 pm) or forwarded to the State 4-H Fair if qualified (1 per Division).
7. All remaining general rules for the Kittitas County Fair apply to all Creative Kids Projects.
8. There will be no premium money for Creative Kids Exhibits.

9. Rosettes will be awarded in each age group of each Division.

#### DIVISION 72-A ..... CREATIVE ART

##### "Patriotic Crafts"

Use any medium.

The creation should be usable. A 3" x 5" card must accompany the entry describing how the entry was made and its use.

Maximum size of the entry is 18" x 18" x 18".

Items may be made from a pattern or may be an original design.

While other decorative items may be used in the creation, it must be primarily made from duct tape

#### DIVISION 72-B ..... CREATIVE RECYCLING

##### "Metal/Tin Cans"

Items must be made from metal and or tin cans. Other decorative items may be used but the focus shall remain on the can.

Plants are not to be included as part of any entry in this class A 3" x 5" card must accompany the entry describing how the item was made and its use.

All items are to be constructed by the member.

Maximum size of the entry is 18" x 18" x 18".

#### DIVISION 72-C ..... CREATIVE CULINARY

##### "Quick Breads"

All entries, including icing, shall be made from scratch. Items that require refrigeration will not be allowed. All entries must be baked.

Entries must be standard sized loaves, either 9" x 5" or 8" x 4"

Items containing raw eggs will not be allowed.

All entries must include the recipe used in preparing the item.

An entry will consist of ¼ loaf. Bring your entry on a sturdy disposable plate and sealed in a plastic bag or in a disposable box.

Alcoholic items may not be used in the preparation of entry.

**DIVISION 72-D .....CREATIVE POETRY**  
**“Winter”**

Entries must be original work completed within the past year.

Each entry is limited to one 8-1/2” x 11” page.

Printing must be 12 point or larger, easily read font, or neatly hand printed.

Illustrations are permitted but must be contained within the one page.

Entries may be metered, free verse, haiku, or any other style of poetry.

**DIVISION 72-E ..... CREATIVE PHOTO**  
**“Animal Photos”**

Photos must be either 5’ x 7’ or 8” x 10”

All photos must be firmly mounted on mat board. Minimum mat margin is 1” on all sides. Maximum mat margin is 2” on all sides.

All entries must be printed on photographic paper.

Photos must show some aspect of your vacation... whenever and wherever it may be.

Photo label (CO890) should be completed and attached to the entry.

Framed entries and non-mounted entries will not be accepted.

Photos must have been taken by the 4-H member.

All photos must be captioned.
